# **Outdoor Electrical Safety**

ALL OUTDOOR OUTLETS, LIGHTING FIXTURES, AND BULBS SHOULD BE WEATHERPROOF AND PROTECTED BY GROUND-FAULT CIRCUIT INTERRUPTER (GFCI) BREAKERS.



## **Extension Cords & Tools**

#### EXTENSION CORDS ARE NOT FOR LONG-TERM USE.

- Check to make sure any cords you use are not damaged. If they are, do not use them.
- Before using an extension cord, ensure it's designed for outdoor use.
- Store unused electrical tools indoors and keep tools out of reach from children.

### **Power Lines**

- Watch out for downed power lines, they may still be electrified. Stay at least 35 feet away.
- Be careful when using ladders in the vicinity of power lines.
- Teach children not to play with toys such as kites around power lines.
- Some power lines may be underground.
  Call 8-1-1 before digging.
