## 4 years old and up\* BOOSTER SEAT



Lap and shoulder belt must be used. The rear seat of the passenger side of vehicle.

## 2 to 4 years old\* FORWARD-FACING CAR SEAT



Rear seat on the passenger side of the vehicle.

## 8 years old OR at least 57" tall SEAT BELT



Restrained with an adult seat belt. Buckle children in back seat until they are 13.

\*or until child exceeds height or weight limit allowed by manufacturer

## **Installation Tips:**

- A properly installed car seat will not move more than an inch. To test it, shake the car seat at the base, where secured.
- Make sure the harness is tightly buckled. With the chest clip placed at armpit level, pinch the strap at the child's shoulder. If you are unable to pinch any excess webbing, the harness is correctly tightened.
