## Reduce Your Risk

- Buckle up - it's the law.
- Adjust the seat, mirrors, and climate controls before putting the car into gear.
- Don't use your phone while driving - texting while driving is illegal in SC.
- Avoid distractions.
- Be aware of other drivers.
- Maintain a four-second distance between you and the car in front of you.
- Remain alert to changing road conditions.
- Avoid driving while tired.
- Have your vehicle serviced regularly.



## In Case of a Vehicle Fire

- Pull to the side of the road, put the vehicle in park, and set the emergency brake.
- Turn off the ignition.
- Get out immediately.
- Stay out of the roadway and move as far away as safely possible.
- Call 9-1-1.
- Do not return to the car.
