OUTDOOR BURNING THINK before you burn!



KNOW THE LAW

State law requires citizens to **notify the SC Forestry Commission** before burning yard debris. Find the toll-free burn notification number for your county: https://www.scfc.gov/protection/fire-burning/how-to-notify/



WEATHER CONDITIONS

Never burn on windy or dry days. Also, consider the time that has passed since the most recent rainfall.



TO BURN OR NOT TO BURN

Burn only dry, natural vegetation. Burning household trash is illegal and may release toxic chemicals into the air.



LOOK UP AND AROUND

Confirm the area above is free of power lines or overhanging tree limbs, and the area around is clear of debris within a 10-foot radius.



STAY WITH THE FIRE

Don't ever leave a fire unattended. Fire can easily spread.



DROWN IT OUT

Keep water handy at all times. When you are finished burning, repeatedly pour water over the area, even after you think it is extinguished.
